

PROCEDURES FOR NOMINATIONS
SAGKEENG FIRST NATION: APRIL 11, 2023 ELECTION

1. The nominator and nominee (prospective candidate) are to fill out Form B to register the nomination.
2. The Candidate or nominator, may bring the filled-out Form B to the electoral assistants, with the Criminal Record check and Child Abuse Registry check (Vulnerable Sector Screening) check or proof of application (receipt). If applied for, all checks must be produced by March 24, when the ballots get printed. Otherwise, candidates will not be on the ballot.
3. Those nominators or candidates who have to be absent for nomination may send the written statement of their absence through the nominator or prospective candidate. To acquire Form B, inquiries may be sent to jamieletander@outlook.com, stanfontaine7@gmail.com, or nowge6@hotmail.com.
4. Each nomination will be read out to the public, and the nominator will be asked why they are nominating the candidate. The candidate will be asked also why they are accepting or rejecting the nomination.
5. Any written statements and nomination forms received through the nominator or candidate will be read by the Electoral Officer or one of the assistants. The statement will briefly explain the reason for absence and why they are nominating or accepting/rejecting the candidacy. The written statement may be emailed to the Electoral officer or one of the assistants as given for the email addresses above before the nominations on February 13, 2023.
6. Nominators can only nominate a person once. Seconders can only second a nomination once as well.
7. If someone is nominated for both Chief and Councilor, that person must indicate which position they are running for before the end of the nominations meeting.
8. A public notice of all qualified candidates will be posted by the Electoral Officer and Team as soon as possible after the nominations meeting.
9. Candidates can withdraw by filling out Form E, no later than March 21, 2023 which is 21 days before the election.
10. All nominated candidates have the option of participating in a public forum to present their views and/or platforms to the public. The public forum will be announced, posted and arranged in March, 2023.
11. Electors can fill out Form D with their addresses and/or email addresses to receive information from the candidates or from the Electoral Officer when required. Form D will be available at the Nomination meeting. Candidates will be required to leave their contact information with the assistant secretary during the nomination meeting.
