#### INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Sagkeeng Visioning Strategy Community Survey! This survey is in support of a new Sagkeeng-led Visioning Strategy Project. The project's goal is to develop a community-led vision for the lands within the old Whiteshell nuclear facility.

#### Background

Canadian Nuclear Laboratories (CNL) is finishing a draft plan for the Whiteshell site called a Land Use End State Plan. This plan will explain how they intend to manage leftover waste and what the site will look like after the old nuclear facility is shut down. It will show where, in their opinion, certain activities can safely happen on the land, and where public access will need to be restricted.

Sagkeeng has concerns about this plan and is undertaking a project to develop a community-led vision for the Whiteshell site. The project involves working with members to develop a Visioning Strategy that will focus on what's important to us, our concerns, and what we want for the future of the site. The final Visioning Strategy will guide our discussions with the Crown and CNL and help to ensure that decisions about the site's future reflect what matters most to Sagkeeng.

We will be holding in-person community engagement events about this project in Spring 2025. **But first,** we need to understand the best ways to involve you. This survey will help us learn about your priorities, what you already know about the site, and what you hope Sagkeeng will achieve through this project.
